The EURAMED rocc-n-roll project will deliver

- a strategic research agenda in the field of medical applications of ionising radiation based on wide stakeholder input and consultation to advise on the priorities of future research
- a medical radiation protection roadmap outlining the short and long-term goals of the research priorities identified in the SRA, calculating necessary budgets for the research to be performed, and providing guidance on the scope and scale of the research
- an interlink document, integrating the views and identifying synergies from European radiation protection platforms and health and digitization programmes

The EURAMED rocc-n-roll consortium is made up of a multidisciplinary team of 29 partners from leading research institutions in 17 European countries. It brings together relevant disciplines including radiation biology, medical dosimetry, ethics, and clinical expertise, complemented by regulatory and health policy, AI, and industry experts.
